

CHESHIRE FAIR SUMMER SHOW CIRCUIT

Welcome to the 2011 Cheshire Fair Summer Show Circuit! This year we are offering three shows to be held at the Cheshire Fairgrounds. The dates are **May 22, June 12, and Aug. 21, 2010**. These shows will be held Sundays and will begin at 8:30 am rain or shine. At the current time, we are planning on using the outside arena since the new footing is outstanding and we now have the addition of a new sprinkler system to water the ring as well.

New this season we will be offering an **Academy Rider Division**. Riders in this division are students who are currently taking riding lessons and would like to try showing before investing in a full show outfit. Horses used for this division are to be horses that are regularly used for lessons. Horses may be shown in a snaffle bridle (martingales allowed) Pelham or full bridle. Riders are not required to ride in full suits. This division is open to all three seats and all ages including adults. See the full listing of rules for this division in the show info section

Riders joining this circuit will accumulate points in their divisions towards end of the season circuit championships awards. The Circuit Championship Awards will be presented at the conclusion of the last show. Details on membership and points are included in this show packet.

Stalls are available and you are welcome to come the day before and spend the night. The arenas will be available for practice on Saturday after 3:00 pm. Please do not arrive before 3:00 pm on Saturday unless you have cleared an earlier arrival time with management.
