

The Cheshire Fair Summer Show Circuit will be awarding circuit champion awards in the following Divisions. A rider does not have to show in all classes offered in their division to qualify for Circuit awards, nor do they have to show in all three shows, **HOWEVER**, the award will go to whoever accumulates the most points in that division so it is in your best interest to do as many classes as possible to maximize your points. Your halter class should be appropriate for your seat and your showmanship class should be appropriate for you age and division.
