AGRICULTURAL EXHIBITORS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR VEHICLE PASS(ES) IN ONLY ONE DEPARTMENT

NO DOGS ALLOWED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS
(With the exception of dogs for the handicapped impaired)

CAMPING

(See Camping & Parking Rules below for Details)

NON-AGRICULTURAL CAMPING (*per night*):
All sizes with or without hookups \$25.00

Agricultural Camping:
Per night with or without hookups \$15.00
Full Week with or without hookups \$60.00
Tent (*per night*) \$10.00

Hookups include water and 20-amp electrical outlet and are subject to availability. Campers needing more than 20-amp service will pay an additional fee based on amps used as follows:

30 amps	\$4 per night	\$20 per week
40 amps	\$8 per night	\$40 per week
50 amps	\$12 per night	\$60 per week
60 amps	\$16 per night	\$80 per week

Anyone with a hose hooked up to CFA water supply is responsible for having and installing a backflow device to prevent back siphonage at the fixture and will be subject to inspection.

CAMPING & PARKING REGULATIONS

CAMPING

- All camping shall be done in the areas designated for camping. All campers must have a camper pass to enter the Gate and will report to the Camping Superintendent upon arrival to be checked in and assigned a spot. One vehicle per camper will be allowed to park in the camping area - all other vehicles will be directed to the hill behind the arena. If you have any questions, please contact the Fair Office at 357-4740.
- Exhibitors having trucks, trailers and cars that will not be in general use the length of the Fair will be required to park them in designated area behind the Draft Horse Barn.
- Any vehicle that is slept in will be considered a camper.**
- Agricultural campers must pre-register their campers when submitting their Livestock & Camping Entry Form. Upon receipt of Entry Form, a camping pass will be sent to you. Camping rates include water & 20amp electricity and are subject to availability.
- Air conditioners and electrical heaters are not allowed.
- Rate does not include septic service. A-1 Enterprises will be on the grounds each morning (early) if you need service.
- NH State Law - No Gray Water will be drained on the ground - \$100 fine will be imposed.
- Anyone with a hose hooked up to CFA water supply is responsible for having and installing a backflow device to prevent back siphonage at the fixture and will be subject to inspection.

PARKING

- No vehicles will be permitted in the fairgrounds without proper passes. All other vehicles will be directed to the General Parking Lot.
- Vehicles unloading animals, feed or hay may do so prior to 10 AM. No vehicles will be permitted on the grounds after 10 AM, and all vehicles must be off the grounds by 10 AM.
- Vehicles parked in areas other than their designated area will be towed! If in doubt, please contact department superintendent or the fair office.
- These parking regulations are for the benefit of all, and to be a benefit they must be strictly enforced. Please be considerate of your fellow exhibitors and park in designated parking areas only.
- Lock Outs & Jump Starting Vehicle – Due to damage liability, CFA will direct subject to private service.
