RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Entries must be entered between 4-7 PM, Monday, August 1 and picked up between 6-7 PM, Monday, August 8.
2. Only one (1) entry per exhibitor per class.
3. Wildflowers cannot be on the Endangered Species List.
4. Cut flowers & flowers for arrangements grown by exhibitors.
5. No blue ribbon will be awarded in a class with only one exhibitor, unless deemed so by the judge.
6. Entries in Flower Arrangement divisions are judged on general effect: scale, design, balance, color, harmony, and suitability of container, condition of material. Entries in Horticulture divisions are judged on quality and condition of specimens.
7. SWEEPSTAKES: Awarded to the adult and youth exhibitor who accumulates the greatest number of points on entries.
