Welcome to the 2011 Cheshire Fair Horse Show!

Thank you for joining us this year at the fair. We have only made a few changes to our show this year and hope you all will enjoy them. HOWEVER, passes will be mailed to the trainer or person listed on the entry form and if you do not pick up your passes from that person before you arrive at the fairgrounds, you will not be allowed to enter the show grounds without purchasing passes at the gate! No one will be allowed into the grounds without a pass in hand. There will be NO exceptions to this rule. There will be NO refunds on passes purchased at the gate if your passes are waiting inside the grounds when you arrive. Extra passes can be ordered on the entry form but in order to avoid purchasing new ones at the gate, you must contact your trainer or other person listed to receive your passes before arriving at the fair.

On Sunday we will not be taking a lunch break and will show straight through from start time until finished. This will allow for the change in the fair schedule of the Open 4-H horse show. This event has been moved from Wednesday to Sunday following the finish of our show. Please be sure to look at the 4-H class list I have included in our program for your convenience. Their start time will be announced Sunday at the close of our show.

As always, coffee and donuts will be available Saturday and Sunday morning under the hospitality tent. During Saturday's supper break we will offer exhibitors a selection of hors d'oeuvres before the start of the evening session.

We would like to thank Cheshire Goldsmiths for their generous support of our show. The jewelry for the Cheshire Fair Pleasure Challenge classes will be available at the office for viewing before those classes. Please feel free to ask us to show you the "bling" you could win.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Gate 1 is the Entrance Gate for the Horse Show. Arrival will be allow no earlier than 12:00 noon, August 4, 2011 for admission to the grounds, departing no later than 7:00 pm, Sunday August 7, 2011.

EMT/First-aid, food and water are available on the Fairgrounds. There will be a veterinarian on call and a farrier will be on the grounds. No bedding will be provided and bedding **WILL NOT** be sold on the grounds.

CAMPERS: There is space for campers, however, limited hook-ups are available and will be on a first come, first serve basis. Camper fee of \$60 will be charged with an additional fee of \$20 for slide outs/awnings. Tents will be charged \$15 per night. Reservations must be made at the time of entry. All horse trailers being used for tack stalls will be charged \$85. All horse trailers not being used for tack rooms or camping **MUST** be moved to the overflow parking area.

The Cheshire Fairgrounds has a new dumping station for motor homes, 5th wheels and trailers that will be available for individuals staying on the fairgrounds for an event. Arrangements can be made through the fair office or with fair maintenance. FEE \$25.00 (per dump)

1. NH State Law – NO GRAY WATER will be drained on the ground - \$100 fine will be imposed.

2. Anyone with a hose hooked up to CFA water supply is responsible for having and installing a back flow devise to prevent back siphonage at the fixture and will be subject to inspection.

ACCOMODATIONS: The Holiday Inn Express is the exclusive motel of the Cheshire Fair Horse Show. Please mention our show to get your discount rate.

CLASS SPONSORSHIPS: We welcome individuals, stables and business to sponsor classes. When you sponsor a class, your name, stable or business can be announced during the class. If you wish you may also make the award presentation. You can sponsor a class by filling out the class number or type of class on the entry blank when you enter the show. Sponsorship is as follows:

NHH&TA will support the USEF and NEHC and/or any affiliated state organization in any disciplinary action against exhibitors which involves sportsmanship or the good conduct of shows or indebtedness and will extend actions to all NHH&TA Affiliated Shows.

RABIES STATEMENT: All domestic animals entered on the Cheshire Fair grounds must be inoculated for rabies before July 1, 2011. Exhibitors must be able to provide proof of inoculation if requested to do so. Proof must include a state of date inoculation given, name of animals(s) and name of person giving the inoculation. Submission of the enclosed entry form guarantees that the exhibitor has read and complied with this rabies policy. Exhibitors are asked to be careful not to allow animals to bite or salivate on patrons.

2011 PASS POLICY

Two (2) exhibitor passes per horse and one (1) parking pass per tow vehicle will be issued per horse shown with no exceptions! All passenger vehicles will need to park in free general parking on the hill. All extra passes will need to be purchased. Passes will be mailed to the name requested on the entry form. It is your responsibility to connect with this person to obtain your passes. **Passes will not be mailed after 07/25/11.** Post entry passes will be held at Gate 1. If you **do not** have your pass at Gate 1 upon arrival, be prepared to purchase passes at that time. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

NO PASS = NO ADMITTANCE!

No refund on purchased passes will be given inside the gate.

STABLING INFORMATION

STALLS: Stabling is provided through permanent stalls, as well as temporary stalls. You may reserve stalls at \$75 per stall by filling out the appropriate information on your entry form. Exhibitors will be charged for every stall they use. All parties wishing to be stabled together should mail their entries together and complete a block stabling request on the back side of one entry. **NO STALLS** will be reserved without payment or signed blank check. Accurate completion of your stabling reservation form is of prime importance in assuring your reserved stabling!

Tack stalls will be charged \$85. Trailers used for tack will be charged \$85. Exhibitors hauling in and working out of their trailer will be charged a \$20 trailer/truck in fee per day.

Bedding IS NOT being sold on the grounds this year. Bedding can be purchased locally through the Cheshire Horse. Please contact them at (603) 358-3001 to pre-purchase bedding and arrange for delivery to the fairgrounds.

DAY STALLS: Day stalls, if available, will be on a first come first serve basis at \$35 per day. Please call the horse show office at (603) 357-7921 no earlier than noon on Friday if you would like to find out more information on day stalls.

Exhibitors are asked to use common sense stabling their horse(s). Proper and humane care of the animals is expected while stabling on the grounds. Stall checks may be done at any time by the fair personnel and any problem affecting the animals welfare will be addressed and remedied (i.e. horse tied out of reach of water).

SHOW RULES

The Cheshire Fair Association, Cheshire Fairgrounds, NHH&TA, Show Management and all show personnel will not be responsible for any accident, injury and/or loss or property that may occur to any animal, person or property and each exhibitor shall not hold them liable and indemnify them against any legal proceedings.

This show will be conducted under the rules of the New England Horseman's Council and The New Hampshire Horse and Trail Association.

- 1. Pre-entries close July 25, 2011. Entries post marked after July 25, 2011 shall be charged a one-time post entry fee of \$10 per entry. Passes will not be mailed after 07/25/11. Post entry passes will be held at Gate 1.**
2. Post entries will be accepted for classes in the morning session until 6:00 pm the day before the session. Post entries for the afternoon and evening sessions will be accepted until one (1) hour before the start of the session.
3. There will be a NHH&TA fee of \$3 per horse for the first class entered. There will be an office fee of \$8 per entry.
4. All show accounts should be closed by 2:00 pm Sunday. There will be a \$25 charge for accounts that are not closed at the end of the show.
5. A fee of at least \$30 may be assessed for any check returned for "Insufficient Funds". A paperwork processing fee of \$20 will be charged to any exhibitor that sends in an entry and is a "No Show" the day of the show.
6. Cancellation after the official start of the show means forfeit of entry fees, except in the case of an accident to horse or rider. Veterinarian/physician's certificate required.
7. The management reserves the right to decline any entry or request the removal of any entry or person on the grounds.
8. The Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class or change judging assignments in cases of emergency.

9. Out of state horses must be accompanied by evidence of a negative coggins test.
10. Holds will be granted at the discretion of the manager. Management will try to cooperate with an exhibitor requesting a hold, but will not be responsible if a hold is not honored. If a hold is granted, the in gate will held for two minutes, then opened for two minutes before the class is closed. Holds must be requested at least one session before the class you want held.
11. In all classes open to registered animals only, the proper registration name and number must be listed on the entry blank and owners must be prepared to show registration papers to show officials.
12. Anyone riding in beginner or walk-trot classes is NOT eligible for any classes other than those specified for beginners. (Excluding the In-Hand/Model Horse Classes.)
13. Six places will be pinned in all classes unless otherwise stated. Prize money will be awarded as listed under each class.
14. Classes must be paid for in advance or a signed blank check must be left with the show secretary.
15. NO SMOKING is allowed in the barn/stall area.
16. Exhibitors are responsible for damage incurred by them or their horse(s) to barns, show ring or other buildings on the grounds.
17. All dogs must remain leashed and in the barn area or the owner will be fined \$50.
18. The management is not responsible for errors or omissions on the published class list.
19. Unruly or unsound horse may be excused at the judges discretion and the decision of the judge will be final.
20. All equitation riders MUST present NEHC numbers and/or membership cards before they will be allowed to show in the NEHC Medal Classes.

Cheshire County Open Junior Horse Show

- All participants in any 4-H mounted event shall wear a properly fitted SEI approved helmet (ASTM Standard 1163-88), with a secured chin harness, at all times when mounted on an equine or in a vehicle pulled by one or more equines.
- Eligibility. **Open to all youth 8-19 yrs by 1/1/11**
- Entries. Pre-entries must be postmarked on or before July 6.
- Pre-entries: 4-H members free entry for one division, however your pass fees must accompany your entry. 4-H approval form to be mailed with your entry. Non 4-H: \$15 entry per horse. Pass fees must accompany entry.
- Post entry: \$25 for every entry. Each horse/rider combination or division is considered a separate entry. 4-H approval form to be presented at registration if entering Fit & Show.
- Passes. Pass fees must be enclosed with your entry for each rider and driver. These fees are for 4-H Exhibitor Passes which only exhibitors, their parents and/or the trailer driver may obtain. They will be mailed to you. All people ages 5 and older must have a pass to enter the grounds or must purchase one at the gate. Gatekeepers will charge regular admission for all those without passes. Refer to info in the front of this book.
- Entering the Grounds: All trailers should enter via the MAIN GATE. Those showing from their trailer will park NORTH of the ring. Those using stalls will drive to the barn area, unload, and then park in the LIVESTOCK LOT on the hill.
- Conduct. Horses may be led or ridden only in the stable area, the ring or directly between. Anyone taking their horse out of the stable and ring area will be disqualified after one warning. This is necessary for reasons of safety. This show will be run in accordance with 4-H Rules & Classes for NH Horse Shows.
- Health. See 4-H Livestock Rule #5.
- Stalls. A limited number of stalls are available in the regular barns on first paid first served basis. A stall fee of \$40 is required. You may not use any stall until you have FIRST obtained a stall card which must be posted on the outside of the stall. \$30 will be refunded if stall is stripped when you leave. Tack stalls - allowed if space permits with same fee structure.
- Arrangements for stall space during the open show must be made with the open stable manager. Those entering the open show must check with open show management to obtain their stall assignment. NO 4-H members will be stabled in TENT unless proof of open show stall assignment is provided. Refer to the horse show section in this book.
- Showing from Trailer – Exhibitors MUST clean up the area around their trailer, placing manure in designated areas and trash in receptacles before leaving. Premiums will be withheld for any not complying.
- Rider may ride more than one seat. A separate entry fee and number is required for each division.
- Any class may be divided or combined at the discretion of the show committee. If there are less than 5 entries, classes will be combined where possible.
- Ribbons. A trophy and 6 ribbons will be awarded in each class with the exception of Fit & Show and Beginner A, which are placed Danish.
- Walk Trot A - 1st year of showing, pinned Danish.
Walk Trot B - 2nd year of showing, open and placed as a regular class. Only one year at this level unless tested.
Beginner Walk/Trot/Canter Class. 1st year of cantering - open and placed as a regular class.
- A 2-minute gate call will apply. When class is closed no additional entries will be allowed.
