2. The judge will penalize all entries not properly displayed. Please contact the superintendents for proper method of display.
3. Exhibits must be brought in on Monday, July 27, 4-7 PM.
4. Exhibits must be picked up on Monday, August 3, 6-7 PM. Exhibits not guarded after 7 PM.
5. Each exhibitor may enter any or all classes.
6. Duplicate premiums will be awarded for ties. Duplicate premiums may be awarded in any division having 10 or more entries.
7. A minimum of 3 legal entries in Div. B or 2 legal entries in all other divisions are required to be authorized to purchase an exhibitor's pass.
